Dear WRLG Participants,

In the event you haven't seen a weather forecast for the next 24 hours, it appears that Old Man winter just won't go away. The National Weather Service has issued a Winter Storm Watch for Friday. As of late Thursday morning, projections are for us to receive anywhere from 3 to 7 inches of snow. They are saying, however, that the worst of the storm is to be in the late afternoon to early evening hours on Friday, and that by 2am on Saturday morning the snow should be subsiding.

Given this forecast and the assurances we have received from the Blast to be prepared for us (parking lots and sidewalks cleared), **we are fully committed to maintaining the current schedule** for Saturday's World's Longest Running Lacrosse Game.

In the event the storm is greater than projected or it does not clear out as soon as expected and we would be jeopardizing the safety of our players and their families, **we would begin altering the schedule by cancelling the earlier games.** If this is the case, we would determine what time we could reasonably expect teams to travel and set a new start time for the program. **Teams scheduled for later in the day** (late morning, afternoon, evening, whenever it may be) **would still play at their scheduled times.**

Please understand the four months of planning, communication and hard work, along with the generous support of so many in the community, that has gone into making this a premier event with a significant and worthy cause. **Short of compromising the safety of our participants, this event will be held.**

Lastly, if coaches are now concerned about the next time they may be able to get on their fields, you are welcome to bring additional players than you had

previously planned to get them some playing time.
