- **YORK COUNTY BY-LAWS AND CODE OF CONDUCT (50 mins.):**
 - Initiated the meeting to establish a Disciplinary Board to help Players/Coaches/Parents/Officials to address issues between two clubs →

ACTION: The bulk of the meeting was a discussion including the new members who will sit on our disciplinary board. Documents were shared regarding the vision and mission of US Lacrosse, the PCA and their Code of Conduct. It was agreed that the disciplinary board would meet again in January to share ideas and begin to put into place the methods for how YCLA will handle issues between two different clubs in the 2006 season. Topics to include Green Cards (like York USA Soccer), Game Reports, etc... The disciplinary board does not have to attend the December 18th meeting.

- **OTHER ITEMS (20 mins.):**
 - **BALTIMORE BAYHAWKS** → Rob Myers presented the plan for the 2006 event. The key dates are Sunday, May 7th at Hempfield H.S. and Sunday, May 21st at a site to be determined in York County.
 - **SCOREBOARD FOR SALE** → Rob Myers has asked that anyone interested in purchasing a new scoreboard from him should contact him directly. Rob will be happy to answer any questions and will arrive at a price fair to him and the new owner.
 - **2nd ANNUAL WORLD'S LONGEST GAME DATE** → March 18, 2006 is the date that I have requested and has been penciled in by SoccerBlast. The owner of the Blast wants to know if the 25th of March would be an option. At the next meeting, I will ask the Board members to survey their teams and clubs to determine how many teams from each club could play on either one of those two dates. A decision will be made in late January based on the Members responses.
 - **LAXFEST 2006:** → Tom Ensminger, on behalf of the Dallastown (Wildcat) Lacrosse Club made a brief presentation to ask for approval to host the 2006 Laxfest. It was voted by the Board to accept this motion and the event will be held at York Township Park with several fields being available for play. More to follow in early 2006 in regards to details. The date of the event will be Saturday, May 20th, 2006.
