- YORK SPORTS NIGHT – 1/25/06
  - Bob Rhein has been invited to MC a lacrosse introduction at the 42<sup>nd</sup> Annual York Sports Night at the old Central High School on Wednesday, January 25<sup>th</sup>. An invitation was extended to each of the Executive Committee members to invite 1-2 players to attend that evening to be part of the demonstration. An email to the Executive Committee Members will be sent in the next week which will provide more details. This is being done to promote the growth of lacrosse in York County. An estimated 1,400 people will be attending the event at Central.
- DIRECTOR'S INSURANCE
  - A motion was made and approved to order Director's Insurance through US Lacrosse before the end of the year. Bob Rhein will order it on-line and will pay for it completely. Total cost is estimated at \$385. Each sanctioned Club (Red Lion & Kennard-Dale were voted and approved as members during this meeting) will be responsible for reimbursing Bob at the next meeting. Estimated expense per Club (11) is \$35 for a total of \$385.
- MDOC/WDOC SPORTSMANSHIP CARD
  - Conversation took place regarding the CARD as a means of better managing the behavior of the players, coaches and spectators for our 2006 season. In our January session, the Disciplinary Board will further review this and determine at what levels this will be instituted for this coming year. - OPEN TOPICS:

- 1). PAYMENT FOR OFFICIALS AT ALL LEVELS

Discussion was initiated as a result of confusion among the various sanctioned Clubs who were in attendance (8) regarding the procedures for paying the officials for the 2006 season. Although historically all the teams and Clubs agreed to always split the costs of the officials (in York County), a motion was made to change the method for

2006. It was recommended that the HOME team pay for both officials for this coming season, regardless of the level of play. Based on a vote of 6 in favor and 2 Clubs opposed (Dallastown and York Suburban), the motion was passed which will now mean that the HOME team will be responsible for all the officials' fees (and assignor's fees) per event. In the case where both teams are playing at the neutral field, the team listed as the HOME team in the official scorebook as well as on the assignor's website will be responsible for the fees. The Executive Committee Club representatives will discuss this in more detail within each of the Clubs and will be responsible for answering any questions that may arise from this decision. Please contact your own Club Executive Committee Member should you have any concerns or issues with this Y.C.L.A. decision.
