- **2<sup>ND</sup> ANNUAL WORLD'S LONGEST RUNNING LACROSSE GAME**

The event for 2006 has been cancelled. Bob Rhein shared with the group that The Blast is not available on March 18<sup>th</sup>, 2006. Although The Blast had the date reserved from last April, the conflict came about when both Christmas and New Years fell on the weekends for 2005. This caused The Blast to miss two consecutive weekends for indoor soccer, which in turn pushed the schedule back for 2006 by two weeks. Based on the limited feedback received by Bob, most teams that responded to the survey last week indicated they could only play if it were on the 18<sup>th</sup>. Most teams start their games the weekend of the 25<sup>th</sup> and therefore would not be able to participate. We will look to try again in 2007.

- **YORK SPORTS NIGHT – 1/25/06**

Bob Rhein went through final details for the 42<sup>nd</sup> Annual York Sports Night. All Clubs were invited to send 1-2 players each to the event. As of 1/25/06, the event was held and it was a success. YCLA had 12 players participate and both local newspapers had pictures featured in the sports section with Andy Frye catching the ball.

- **DIRECTOR'S INSURANCE**

Brief discussion took place regarding the policy. The policy is in place effective on 12/27/05 and will run for one year. All Clubs who are part of YCLA and voted in as members (10) are covered under this policy. Total cost of policy is \$385. All Clubs reimbursed Bob Rhein for \$35 except Spring Grove and Central York who will be mailing checks before next meeting.

- **MDOC/WDOC SPORTSMANSHIP CARD**

Lengthy discussions took place for the first 30 minutes of the session with all the Executive Members and Disciplinary Board Members discussing the sportsmanship card and the use of the sideline manager. Documents were circulated regarding the incorporation of the sideline manager into the NFHS Rulebook as adopted by the Youth Council per US Lacrosse. A motion was made and a vote was taken to adopt and approve the use of the sideline manager at all Youth level games in York County this spring. There were nine clubs who voted to accept this and one club (Spring Grove) who abstained. The motion was passed. This includes all levels consistent with US Lacrosse (Senior/Junior/Lightning/Bantam= Middle School/Youth 5-6/Youth 3-4). With this also came the request to each club to poll their high school coaches and program managers to determine whether to implement this for 2006 at the boys H.S. level. A vote will be taken in February. Also discussed was the development of the green card (York USA Soccer) which Bob Rhein will have a draft of for the February meeting.

- **MANDATORY MEETING – COACHES 2/14/06**

The Committee agreed to postpone the Coaches meeting until March. TJ shared that there are a number of pending meetings in February (see below) which might cause a limited turnout to our meeting. It was also noted that this tentative date was President's Weekend and possible travel issues with families not being in the area.

- WEST YORK
  - A High School parent contacted us about a place for their son to play as a West York student. Both Central and Spring Grove offered to help and will be in touch with the parent. In addition, there will be a no charge clinic on 1/27/06 offered to 3<sup>rd</sup>/4<sup>th</sup> grade boys from the West York School District to promote lacrosse. If enough boys attend, West York may introduce a new Youth team this spring. At the next meeting, the decision to move forward with a new team and new club will be shared with all the members.

  - Discussion occurred regarding the Old Central HS property and a few of the clubs are looking at the feasibility of this site.
  
- FEBRUARY MEETINGS FOR LACROSSE (NON-YORK AREA)
  - TJ shared that the CPSLA meeting is penciled in for 2/8/06 and that Harry Mazaheri would be notifying all the HS coaches in the D-III. The CPLOA is hosting their meeting on 2/16/06 and Bill Middleton and JT Noll will advise in more detail regarding this meeting.
