- There was a lot of conversation from both sides of this topic. Based on the pros and cons, a motion was made to put off the use of the sideline manager at the High School boys level until a future season. The vote was unanimous at 7-0 in favor of putting it off. Please be aware that at all the other levels of play for boys, the sideline manager will be initiated this spring as voted in during our last session.

- BLUE CARD – REVIEW OF DATA

- At one of the prior meetings, it was suggested that we adopt the same type of method that York USA Soccer uses (theirs is a green card). A template was shared and a few changes were made. The Blue Cards will be printed and distributed at the coach's meeting in March. All Boys teams at all levels will be required to use this card. It's primary function is to track players who have been ejected at anytime during the season. Coaches after each game will be required to sign the Blue card. A motion was made to accept the use of the Blue cards this spring. The vote was unanimous at 7-0 to initiate this program.

- MANDATORY MEETING – COACHES 3/12/06

- There will be mandatory coaches meeting for all Boys coaches from Youth through High School. The meeting date will be March 12<sup>th</sup>. The tentative time will be from 5:00 pm to 6:30 pm. Anyone who will be coaching this spring either as a head coach, assistant coach or helper on the field will be required to attend this meeting. A full agenda and details of the meeting will be emailed in the next week to all the current contacts in York County.
