- **TOPICS:**

- **DISCIPLINARY BOARD LOGISTICS:**

Discussion took place about how the information should be shared from a Club and ultimately presented to the Board. All the ECM's and DB members felt it was best to make sure the ECM for every Club would be the primary person to communicate any information. Coaches and volunteers in Clubs should always communicate their concerns to their ECM and let the ECM take the next step.

- **LAXFEST – MAY 20<sup>TH</sup>:**

Tom Ensminger updated the Committee on a variety of bullet points. Look for an additional email to be sent in the next week outlining all the final details for Laxfest on May 20<sup>th</sup>.

- Bill Marks offered to contact Bill Middleton about the officials for the day.
- Game times will be four (4) 15-minute running quarters if possible.
- Tom Ensminger to handle jerseys, fields, YSPI photos, painting lines, goals...
- Albert Hoffman has offered to help with the event program  
Tom will advise in the next week the final costs which each Club will be responsible for paying the day of the event including all the game jersey expenses and officials fees. Each Club will be invoiced on game day. All levels will be able to invite four field players along with one goalie if they have someone who is able to play that position.

- **BY-LAWS – PLAYER PARTICIPATION:**

Conversation took place regarding defining the rosters for each Club and at what level will we allow there still to be some gray area. The committee agreed that all Clubs will try their best to register players next year who attend their appropriate schools. In the event there is a player who registers with another Club even though he should register elsewhere, the ECM's shared that there must be conversation, knowledge, communication and approval between both Clubs before that player can play. Conversation also took place regarding playing time at all levels of play. Our By-Laws clearly state that we are playing to the Blue Book (NFHS 2006 Rulebook) and all coaches should review the outline provided in the back of the book.

Every person who is truly looking to help the sport grow and to help the YCLA improve should consider participating on the subcommittees that will form in July. Most of these committees are outlined in our By-Laws. We will have elections for Officers during our July meeting as well.

TJ expressed how well it worked for the CPSLA High School all-star selection process. Dave asked that in July, we begin to share in the expense of hosting the site. The fees are minimal at this time however.
